ダ・ビンチ、ショスタコービッチ、シューマン、パスカル、クレー、ラミュ、スタンダール、デ・キリコ、シレー、ヘミングウェイ、シェークスピア、など

「天才芸術家と脳神経障害」シリーズ第3部では、急性・慢性神経性疾患と闘った画家、音楽家、文筆家の症例を取り上げています。闘病に敗れた症例（ショスタコービッチ、シューマン、ヴォルフ、パスカルなど）をはじめ、クレー、ラミュのように、疾病障害に起因する力強く奇異な創作力で作品に深い影響を及ぼした症例も紹介。罹患者本人が症状を観察し最初の記録を残した例もあります。スタンダールは脳卒中で死亡する前に自ら失語症一過性脳虚血発作の詳細を記録していました。稀な例ですが、デ・キリコやシレーのように、神経的疾患が不確定なままその芸術家の作品の特徴とされた例も挙げています。本書の章の中にはシェークスピアやデュマによる記述を含め、芸術作品の中に見られる神経症に焦点を絞ったものもあります。芸術家と神経学的症状の双方にライトをあてた本書は、神経科医、精神科医、一般内科医をはじめ、美術、文学、音楽など芸術を愛好するすべての読者にとって有益な興味深い読み物となることでしょう。

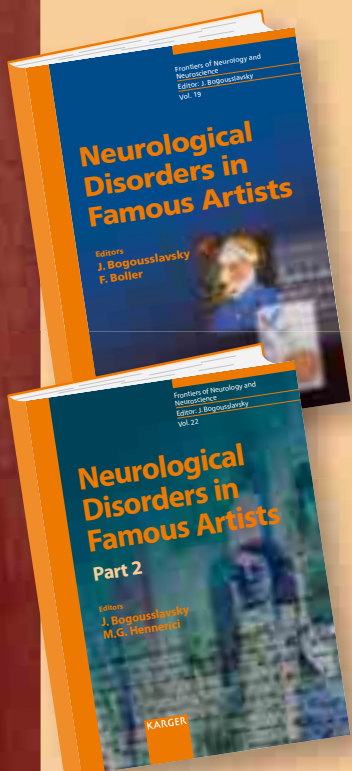
